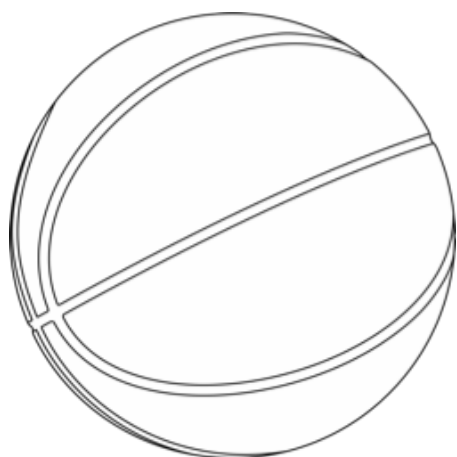

Summarizing means that we are taking a larger selection of text and retelling the selection using fewer words. We are only telling about the most important parts of the story.

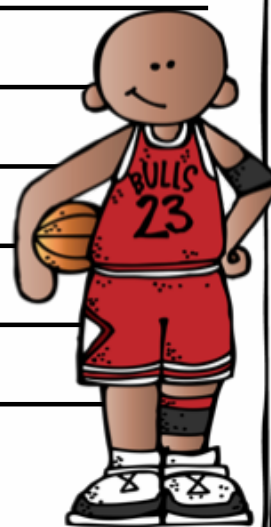

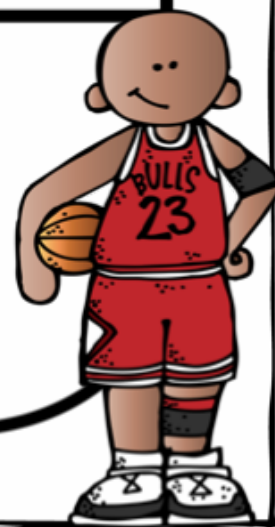

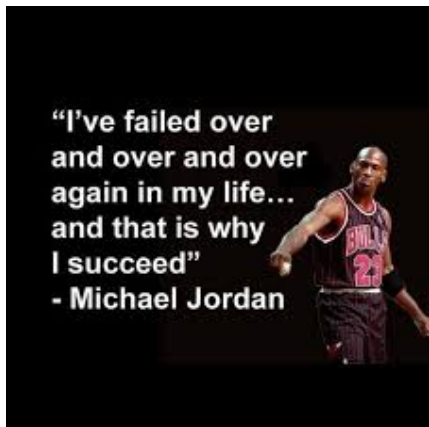

(Page 10) The newspaper say 'Michael Jordan is the best.' Write an article for the newspaper about Michael. (You can use PicCollage to add pictures).



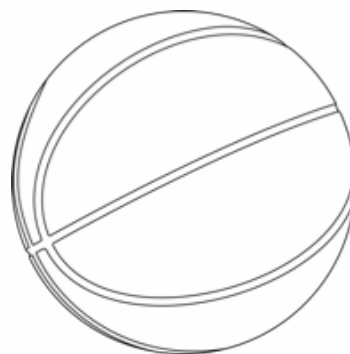
Task Card #7
