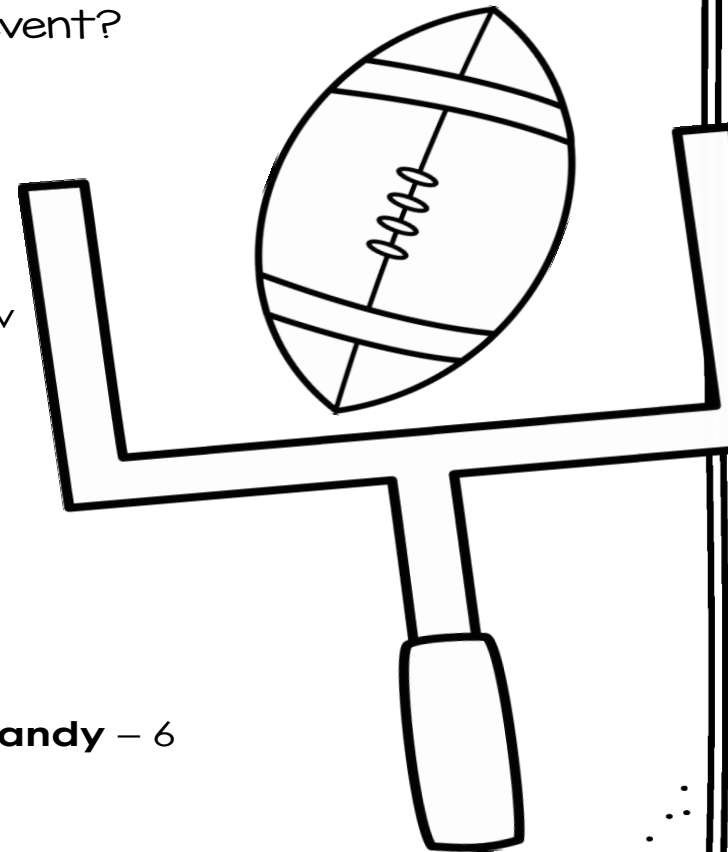

For this important day, spectators are welcome, but they need their ticket. Follow the instructions to create Cool Cats game ticket.

Ticket Designer

- The gate number must be an even number that is a multiple of three.
- The section number must be a two-digit number that is odd.
- The row number must be a two-digit number whose digits equal a sum of 12.
- The seat number must be a three-digit number whose tens digit is two more than the ones digit.
- The date must include the month, day, and year (for this year's game).
- The time must include AM or PM.
- The price must be an odd three-digit number between 200 and 300.
- The game number must be written in Roman Numerals.
- The host city's name should be included in the design, which should represent the city somehow.




